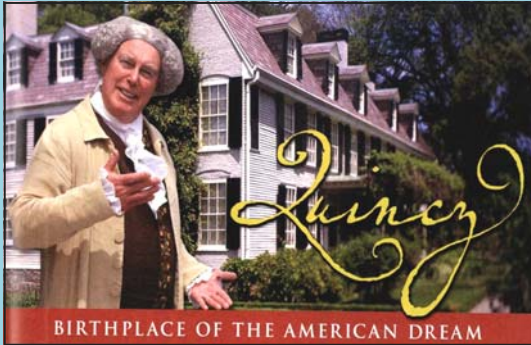


M.I.L.E presents:
